

## CALL: POST-DOCTORAL POSITION UNIVERSITY CENTER OF BRASILIA - CEUB

The University Center's Master/PhD Law and Public Policy Program is inviting applications for one Post-Doctoral Position. This position is funded by the Fundação de Apoio à Pesquisa do Distrito Federal (Research Foundation of the Federal District) with a monthly scholarship of 8,000 Brazilian reais for a period of 12 months, starting in May 2025.

## **Eligibility Requirements:**

- 1. The position is opened to both Brazilian and international applicants who hold a PhD in Law. They can be junior or senior researchers.
- 2. Candidates must have a strong research and publication record.
- 3. Proficiency in Portuguese is recommended, as well as a good command of English and Spanish (both oral and written).
- 4. Preference will be given to candidates with the ability to work in an interdisciplinary environment.
- 5. Preference will be given to candidates having the aptitude to work with domestic, international and transnational law and their interaction with public policy.
- 6. Candidacies from women, Afro-descendants, and Indigenous people are warmly encouraged.

## Responsibilities of the Post-Doctoral Fellow:

- 1. Develop and conduct research while engaging with ongoing projects within the University Center's Master/PhD Program in Law and Public Policy.
- 2. Join one of the Program's research groups and/or contribute to the activities of the Business, Human Rights, and Public Policy Clinic.
- 3. Assist in the organization of academic events hosted by the Program, as needed.
- 4. Present two to four seminars per semester on the fellow's research.
- 5. Serve as an assistant editor for the Brazilian Journal of International Law and/or the Brazilian Journal of Public Policy, contributing to their activities.
- 6. Remain based in Brasília, Brazil, for the whole duration of the fellowship.
